Dropshipping

Dropshipping makes new millionaires every single year.

But it's still quite an overlooked side hustle.

Many people think you have to have a huge budget or invest in lots of stock to get started.

But it couldn't be further from the truth.

In fact, you can get started for less than \$30 per month.

And it can be done in just a few steps:

#1 – Choose a selling platform

If you want to dropship, then you're going to need an online platform to post your products.

The most popular platform is Shopify. For less than \$30 a month, you can have your own eCommerce store, live and packed with products within a day or less.

#2 – Find Products for Your Store

This can be another sticking point for many people too.

How do you find hundreds of products to add to your store?

Well, the great news is there are apps for that!

You can use an app such as Dsers which integrates with AliExpress and your Shopify store.

AliExpress has millions of products to choose from and can be imported into your store in just a few clicks using the Dsers app. Then the whole sales process is really simple:

- Once you've added products to your store, you can then market it to the public.

- When someone places an order, they pay you.

- You then order the item from AliExpress, who then ships the product to your customer.

- You then keep the profit.

You don't need to touch a single product yourself. Everything is done completely hands free *(other than clicking a few buttons)*.

That's what makes dropshipping a perfect side hustle that can be done from your kitchen table!

Freelancing

You probably already have a skill that other people will pay for.

If not, then you can learn one very quickly.

Once you have that skill, you can then charge people for small tasks. These are often called gigs.

There are lots of these 'gig' websites, where people advertise their services.

They include:

- <u>Fiverr</u>
- Craiglist
- Upwork
- Remote.co
- Freelancer

People looking to hire, visit these websites and choose people to work with.

Often, a small gig can lead to regular paid work.

Some of the types of gigs you can offer include:

- Graphic design
- Search Engine Marketing
- Translation
- Video Creation

- Animations

- Music
- Software Development
- Social Media Marketing

You just need to **have/learn** a skill and then you can get paid for it, from the comfort of your own home.

Affiliate Marketing

Affiliate marketing is where you promote products from companies and get paid a percentage for each sale you make.

There are lots of benefits to this business model, including:

- No products to create
- No customers to deal with
- No refunds or chargebacks to deal with
- No expensive overheads
- Can get started fast

With this model, you basically find products you want to promote *(these can be physical products or digital products)* and join the affiliate program for the company selling them.

Most large retailers such as Amazon, eBay, BestBuy etc have their own affiliate programs.

All you do is join the program and you'll be given your own unique link to promote their products.

When you make a sale, you automatically get a commission for that sale.

Physical products will pay on average 2% up to 10%.

Digital products though can pay as much as 75% or more.

A great place to find digital products is ClickBank, which has hundreds to choose from in various categories. You can get started with affiliate marketing with zero investment.

All affiliate programs are free to join. Then you just need to put your unique affiliate link in front of people who might be interested in buying.

You can do this for free on social media websites such as YouTube, Facebook, Twitter, TikTok, Pinterest or Instagram.

Start A Blog

Having your own blog can be an asset that pays you hundreds or even thousands of dollars every single month.

And it can be run from literally anywhere where there is an internet connection. So it's ideal if you fancy living the laptop lifestyle!

A blog is simply a website, where you post article/videos about something you're passionate about.

This can be your profession or a hobby you love to do.

Once you start posting to your blog, it will start to be indexed in search engines like Google. That where you can start getting people to visit your blog.

They will read/watch what you're posting and will follow you. These fans can become very lucrative as your blog grows.

There are many ways to get started for free. You can simply find a free blogging platform such as WordPress.com, Wix or Medium.

However, if you want to be more professional, you can buy a domain name from Godaddy and have a self-hosted blog on a host such as Bluehost.

This makes your blog a lot more professional and easier to find.

You can of course market it on social media too, you don't have to rely on search engines to send you visitors.

How To Make Money with Blogging?

So you might be asking how do you actually make money with your own blog.

Here are a few ways to do just that:

- Add links to affiliate products (see previous side hustle above).

- Add paid advertising

- Sell your own merchandise

There are lots of ways to monetise your blog once you have visitors and fans coming to it every day.

Print On Demand Store

Want to sell your own merchandise?

Then this side hustle is for you!

Having your own print on demand store allows you to do just that. Whether it's t-shirts, mugs, bags, hats, phone cases or more.

What exactly is print on demand?

Similar to having your own dropshipping store, you basically have an online storefront. This could be a Shopify store, Etsy store or any other platform you choose.

You then fill it full of products with designs of your choice. You can have designs created very inexpensively on websites such as Fiverr.

Once a customer buys an item, you then send that order to the print on demand store. They will then print and ship the item to your customer, and you keep the profit.

So just like dropshipping, it can be done totally hands-free.

Here are some of the best print on demand companies to use:

- Printful
- Printify
- CustomCat
- Teelaunch

You can get very creative with your stores too.

Maybe create one about dogs.

Or one about cooking.

You don't have to have one store, you can create several smaller niche stores.

If you use platforms like Etsy, then the customers you need are already on there looking.

You don't have to wait for your store to rank in the search engines.

Print on demand is a fast way to build your brand and start making sales of your own physical products.
